



PF+C Cofounder Allan Paul Elected Trustee Emeritus to Vermont Law School

In February 2008, Paul Frank + Collins cofounder R. Allan Paul was elected a Trustee Emeritus to Vermont Law School. Mr. Paul served on the VLS Board of Trustees from 1994 to 2004. He was President of the Board from 1995 to 2001. In May of 2006, VLS bestowed Mr. Paul with an Honorary Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*. He has also been a guest lecturer at VLS, focusing on his area of legal expertise, trusts and estates.
